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Mini Medical School Program : Creighton University School of Medicine hosted the first-ever Mini Medical School program for first generation students and their families. The students and parents attended the four hour zoom session. Students were in break out rooms and attended six different sessions (led by current medical students) where they learned about medicine, how they body works, and had the opportunity to ask medical students questions. Meanwhile, parents had their own breakout channel where they received information from the admissions office, a presentation about mental health and medical professionals, a presentation about different careers in the healthcare field, and a presentation of how to get into medical school/the path to medicine.
